



Wiring Instructions

Definitions:

Incoming Wire: This is money deposited into Horizon Federal Credit Union from another Financial Institution.

Outgoing Wire: This is money withdrawn from Horizon Federal Credit Union and sent to another Financial Institution within the United States. There are processing fees associated with outgoing wire transfers. Refer to the Fee Schedule for current Wire Transfer Fee.

Incoming Wire:

Note: When you are wiring funds from an international financial institution into Horizon Federal Credit Union, it is that foreign institution's responsibility to wire to their correspondent bank located in the United States, who will then, in turn, wire to Horizon Federal Credit Union using the directions below. Horizon Federal Credit Union does not have an IBAN number or Swift Code.

Outgoing Wire:

We need the following:

- Name of the Financial Institution to where the money is going.
- ABA / Routing Number for the Financial Institution.
- Name on the account where the money will be deposited.
- Full account number.

*****It is always best to check with the financial institution and get their incoming wire instructions, this way you know you will have the correct information for the transaction.*****
